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PROJECT SUMMARY:

The project reacts to one of the problems what youth people face in today in Europe and it's about lack of active citizens in local community. Due to the pandemic situations, young people are actively involved in fewer and fewer civic activities. Because of that, local organizations have less and less volunteers and they do fewer activities than before. In a period when active citizenship is important, solidarity and union between people is necessary we decided to crate and implement this Youth Exchange in order to reach young people from our communities. Youth personality at present is faceing with many challenges than ever before. Not only do most of them have the "don't care" attitude as part of their behavior but also continue to have less and less interest and opportunity to discover what is true in their life, how to work together and how to be empathic with other members of the society. They continue to pursue the world with all sorts of anti-social behavioral characteristics that portray impatience, intolerance, and irresponsibility to society and their workplaces. Because of lack of personal development, youth behavior can be unhealthy and non-productive for them and the society. These facts can make youth people demotivated to become active citizens that can also reduce the employability skills and integration in local community. So in order to come out of this vicious system, we would like to promote a method of raising awareness of the benefits of being an active citizen in the local community. Through the implementation of youth exchange "Active Citizens Today" we aim to develop selfawarness and life long learning process for 24 youth coming from 4 countries for a duration of 9 days of Youth Exchange.

OBJECTIVES:

- Exploring the concept of volunteering, advantages and disadvantages, for 24 young people during the implementation period of the project.
- Improving the quality of human resources of 4 youth organizations coming from Romania, Poland, Croatia and Czech Republic, through all the stages of the project.
- Developing the knowledge, of 24 young people and 4 youth organizations on the opportunities and benefits of Erasmus+ programme and European Solidarity Corps.

PARTICIPANT PROFILE:

For this project we will focus for participants witch are between <u>the age limit of 16 - 19</u> <u>years old.</u> According to the group leader, there will be no age limit, leader have to be more than 18 y.o. The partner organizations will be responsible for selecting participants for the project. The requierment for the organisation will be to keep the gender ballance. Each group si formed by 6 people, witch means ideally 3 girls and 3 boys. We would like to point out that we are also opened for participants who are comming from minorities and LGBTIQ comunity, because in fact personal development is for everyone and we would like to offer equality opportunities for everyone. We would like to have also participants with fewer opportunities (educational, social, geographical, economical and disability), because we consider that this project can have a bigimpact in their personal life, helping them to learn new tools of developing themself, tools what in normal condition can not have so easy. We think that the participants with fewer opportunities can increase the contribution of the project, because the idea of the project is to offer a method of personal development to people who don't have acces so easly to this tools. Also in the project we want to have participants who never participated in Erasmus+ projects, because a new experience like this can have a big impact on them.

In this project *we are not expecting to have high level of eanglish*. We would like to have participate who can understand an comunicate; but there will be the leader who will be responsible for help with translating in case they will need. They don't need to heave previous experience with volunteering; actually the main target group are youth peope who don't have experience in volunteering, because the main goal of the project is to determinate youth people to be more active in their community; but they must be openminded in trying to change something in their life. As we mentioned we want to have newcomers in our Youth Exchange.

In the profile of the participants will be following:

1. Participants will have to be able to speak in english. They have to communicate and understand in english.

- 2. The participants will need to have the motivation in order to participate in the youth exchange.
- 3. They have to be prepared to exit from their confort zone.
- 4. To be familiar with European values.
- 5. To wish to try somenthing new in frame of personal development.

The profile of the leaders:

- 1. Leader must have more than 18 y.o.
- 2. Have to speak and understand in English.
- 3. To have previous experience in youth exchanges and in leading the team.
- 4. To be motivated in helping others in the proces of personal development.

5. To be interestetd and motivated in topic about personal and professional development, European values and civic implication.

Number of participants: 5 per national team + 1 leader.

Accommodation for Youth Exchange:

The youth exchange will take place in *"In the forest Pension" (Pensiunea La Padure)*, located near Reşiţa. The location offers rooms with 2, 3 and 5 beds, each room with private bathroom, one conference room, one dining room, terrace and garden.

✓ Health insurance and ! In case of boo-boos we have our medikit, but for more serious injuries (let's keep our fingers crossed that won't happen), we need

you to have a health insurance for the whole youth exchange.



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✓ **Towel!** The venue will provide us with one set of towels for our stay, so we suggest we bring one more to have with you!



✓ As much **positive energy** as possible! For those of you who want to share some of your energy through energizers, you will have the possibility to do so!
